In 1980 I incorporated Lhasa apso and Pekingeses and in July the F.C.I. granted me the affix BASTERBERRI. Since that date my dogs have won more than 250 championship titles under the F.C.I. and A.K.C. system. I have also owned, bred and presented Italian Greyhound, Greyhound, Spanish Greyhound, Bedlington Terrier, Yorkshire Terrier, American Cocker, Basenjis, Boxer, Great Dane, Shih Tzu, my last breed is the Boston Terrier, with only 4 litters, I got 24 championship titles. I'm Vice-president of the SOCIEDAD CANINA DE BIZKAIA, organizer of the classic BILBAO INTERNATIONAL DOG SHOW.

I am an F.C.I. all breeds Judge and have judged all over Europe, America, Australia, Asia and South Africa and had the honor of judging at the FCI World Dog Show 2020 held in Madrid in 2022.



Gabriel Valdez

Colombia

Gabriel Valdez was born in Cuba but has lived many years in Colombia. In his native Cuba he was founder of the Federacion Cinologica de Cuba, (the FCI recognized club), president of the Collie Club and a member of many breed clubs, including Pointers and Sighthounds. As a breeder-owner-handler, Mr. Valdez has shown his dogs throughout most of Latin America, finishing multiple champions and winning many Groups and Best In Show awards under his kennel name DaVinci's. He has bred the only Best In Show winning Italian Greyhounds in Latin America. Mr. Valdez first litter of Azawakh has produced several champions and Group winners and a BIS winner. Mr. Valdez's goal with the Azawakh is to preserve breed type true to the country of origin together with lively show temperaments. A lover of Sighthounds for many years, he has owned, bred and/or shown Afghan Hounds, Borzois, Whippets, Greyhounds, Saluki and Italian Greyhounds. Other breeds he has successfully shown as a breeder-owner-handler or owner-handler include Basset Hound, Collie, Papillon and Yorkshire Terrier. Mr. Valdez is a member of the Colombian Kennel Club. He is an All Breed FCI judge who specializes in Sighthounds. He has judged in many countries in both North and South America.

Paul is now an All Breeds Judge, having first commenced judging at Championship level in 1989. Paul is currently a Director of the Irish Kennel Club and previously was Chairman of the Judges Committee.

Professor Niksa Lemo is an international championship dog show judge and has judged at many national and international dog shows on all six continents. He was licensed to judge in January 1992 for his first breed, the Doberman Pinscher. In December 2010, he was licensed to judge all FCI breeds. He has judged all groups, Best in Show competitions, and the final of many junior handling competitions to date. He has been invited to judge at the most prestigious shows, such as the World Dog Shows, the European Dog Shows, Westminster (USA), FCI Section's shows, Sydney Royal, and various national specialties of various breeds. Dr. Lemo is a university professor and board-certified veterinary dermatologist (ECVD). He teaches veterinary dermatology and canine science at Zagreb University. He conducts seminars for students, judges, and breeders.

Dr. Lemo is currently a full professor and director of the University Veterinary Hospital of the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, Zagreb. Niksa Lemo breeds Miniature Schnauzers (black and salt and pepper). He has also owned, co-owned, and/or shown Doberman, Pug, Standard Schnauzer, German Shorthair Pointer, Tibetan Mastiff, Tibetan Spaniel, and Norwich terrier.
